CHAPTER-1

Introductory

1.1 It is often said that ignorance of law is no excuse. Thus, the citizens of a State are expected to be familiar with statutes relevant to lives and affairs. Such familiarity cannot be satisfactorily acquired and properly maintained if the statute book contains statutes which are really 'dead' though formally alive.

1.2 Such considerations assume greater significance in modern era when a large number of statutes are enacted almost every year. It becomes practically difficult to handle the statute book. Therein lies the importance of identification of 'dead wood'.

1.3 The Uttar Pradesh State law Commission has *suo motu* taken up for consideration the question of repeal and amendments of certain enactments of State of Uttar Pradesh, as a part of the function of the State Law Commission of making recommendations for keeping the law up-to-date.

1.4 Every legislature is expected to undertake the process of periodical spring-cleaning of the statute book, in order that dead wood may be removed and citizens may be spared the inconvenience of taken notice of laws which have ceased to bear any relevance to current conditions. Certain State Acts which have become obsolete, or which have become anomalous in view of changed conditions, and which therefore need to be repealed or amended. The statute that are not obsolete are formidable enough in size and number.

In order that the statute book may not grow out of all proportion, it is desirable that dead wood should be removed from the statute book and if any enactment requires any amendments it should also be amended accordingly.

1.5 Such exercise may be called as “statute law revision.” The classical exposition of the function of statute law revision is that of Lord Westbury, Lord Chancellor. In 1963, speaking in the debate on the Statute Law Revision Bill, Lord Westbury, thus outlined the principles upon which statute law revision should be based.

“The Statute Book should be revised and expurgated— weeding away all those enactments that are no longer in force and arranging and classifying what is left under proper heads, bringing the dispersed Statutes together, eliminating jarring and discordant provisions, and thus getting a harmonious whole instead of a chaos of inconsistent and contradictory enactments.

1.6 Statutes, unlike human beings, do not die a natural death, with the possible exception of statute whose life is pre-determined by the Legislature at the time of their enactment. A statute, unless it is expressly enacted for a temporary period, survives until it is killed by repeal. A legislative enactment cannot be rendered in effective by mere non-use or obsolescence. The long desuetude of a law does not amount to its repeal. This itself is a consideration for undertaking from time to time measures for expressly repealing enactments that might have become obsolete or spent. The State Legislature should effect a periodic revision of its laws, so that the Statute Book is cleared of law which are obsolete, or spent or which have become anomalous in view of changed conditions.

1.7 The formal repeal of an obsolete Act achieved through a repealing Act is not to be reviewed as a mere technical exercise. It has a wider role to perform and has a place of its own in the working of the legal system. Such a repealing Act is essentially a part of statute law revision, which, in its turn, is comprised within the concept of law reform in its totality.

1.8 The present report is not the first one of the U.P. State Law Commission in a nature of such examination. The U.P. State Law Commission has, in the past, had an occasion for such examination. In 2001, the U.P. State Law Commission examined various enactments of State of Uttar Pradesh and submitted its comprehensive Eleventh Report to the State Government on 11.10.2010, recommending certain amendments in 159 enactments (First Schedule) 116 enactments were recommended for wholly repeal (Second Schedule), 22 enactments were recommended for wholly repeal from the rest of the state as these enactments have already been repealed in certain cases (Third Schedule) and from the year 1948 to the year 2001, 721 amending enactments were recommended for wholly repeal for the reasons mentioned therein.

1.9 Repealing Acts in England- Students of statute law are well acquainted with Repealing and Amending Act. In England, the first statute Law Revision Act was passed in 1856. It repealed 129 obsolete statute. Curiously, one of the Acts repealed by that Act was an Act of 1388 (12 Richard 2, 13), “for the punishment of them which caused corruption near a city or great town, to corrupt the air”.

1.10 Repealing Acts in India- Similar process has been undertaken from time to time in almost all countries. The introduction and initiation of repealing Acts at intervals is a process quite familiar to legislative draftsman in most countries. In India, the first two such Acts were passed in 1866, Repealing Act (11 of 1866) and 1870, Repealing Act (14 of 1870). The last such Act was passed by the Parliament in 2001, the Repealing and Amending Act, 2001 (30 of 2001), by which 357 enactments have been repealed which includes 33 Principle Acts, 4 Repealing Acts and 320 Amending Acts. In 02 enactments certain amendments have been incorporated.

1.11 Repealing Acts in Uttar Pradesh- Uttar Pradesh is not behind in such action. It has also undertaken from time to time similar process. Though, one by one, many particular Act have been repealed by the State Legislature by particular repealing Act or by new enactment, but first three such Acts were passed in 1956 (U.P. Act No. 30 of 1956) was passed, by which 5 principal Acts were repealed while 10 Acts were amended. In the year 1956 another the Uttar Pradesh Repealing and Amending (Second) Act, 1956 (U.P. Act No. 5 of 1957) was passed by which 01 principal Act was repealed while 3 Acts were amended. In 1958 the Uttar Pradesh Repealing and Amending Act, 1958 (U. P. Act No. 32 of 1958) was passed by which 01 principal Act was repealed and 10 Acts were amended. The last such Act has been passed by the State Legislature in 2004, the Uttar Pradesh Repealing Act, 2004 (U.P Act No. 32 of 2004) by which said 3 Repealing and Amending Acts were repealed.

1.12 Said Repealing and Amending Acts transpires that these have not included those various Acts which were recommended for Repeal and Amendments by the Eleventh Report of U.P. State Law Commission.

1.13 The matter was discussed at various meetings of the Commission, held at its head-quarter as well as its Camp Office at Allahabad. As an outcome of the discussions at various meetings, a Draft Report with a Model Draft Bill for “The Uttar Pradesh Repealing and Amending Bill, 2011” prepared by Shri Ishwar Dayal, Full-time Member of the Commission, was finally circulated to all the Members of the Commission and their views were invited thereon. The views on the Draft Report and Model Draft Bill was discussed at a meeting of the Commission held on 29.04.2011. The Report of the Commission which proposed repeal of certain Acts including amending Acts, repealing Acts and certain other enactments which are related to the Utrakhand State and amendments of those provisions in various enactments, which are related to the Utrakhand State, and due to formation of new State, have no relevance for that region, to that extent and in the manner, as mentioned in the Chapter-III of the Report in respective schedule, if not repealed and amended so far, to be submitted to the State Government, has been finally settled, approved and signed by the Chairperson and Members of the Commission at its meeting held on 16 May, 2011.

1.14 We wish to express our appreciation for valuable services and assistance received from Sri Santosh Kumar Pandey, Secretary, of the Commission and Sr. Bhal Chandra Shukla, former Addl. L.R. U.P. former Secretary Vidhan Parishad, U.P. former Chairman of First State Finance Commission of U.P. and former Adviser to U.P. State Law Commission.

1.15 We also acknowledge the valuable services and assistance rendered by the other staff and officials of the Commission.

CHAPTER-II

Principles Followed in Recommending Repeal and Amendments of Enactments

2.1 In dealing with the question whether a particular Act should be repealed or should be allowed to continue on the statute book, we have kept before us certain considerations, which it would be useful to set out.

2.2 In the first place, statutes which are no longer needed, as having become redundant in view of Section 6-C of the Uttar Pradesh General Act, 1904, should be repealed.

2.3 Secondly, statutes which had been enacted for the Uttrakhand region, and due to re-organisation of the State of Uttar Pradesh and formation of a separate Uttrakhand State, now such enactments are not applicable to the Uttrakhand State, should be repealed.

2.4 In the third place, statutes which have certain such provisions which are related to Uttrakhand State, and now such provisions are not applicable to that region, should be amended in appropriate manner.

2.5 Proposals confined to matters in State or Concurrent List-

We may state here that in preparing the list of enactments to be repealed or amended, we have included enactments whose subjects matters clearly falls within State List or Concurrent List of Seventh Schedule of the Constitution of India. We have not considered those Uttar Pradesh State (Amendment) Acts, by which Central Acts have been amended.

CHAPTER-III

Conclusions And Recommendations

3.1 On the basis of the discussions in the preceding Chapters, the following State Acts, we have identified suitable for repeal and amendments. For convenience, we have divided these Acts under three schedules as follows-

3.2 First Schedule

As stated earlier by the Eleventh Report of the Commission, 721 Acts (1948-2001) were recommended for repeal. (Fourth Schedule) this schedule includes only 01 Act of 2001. In the present Report under First-schedule we have examined 201 Acts which include amending Acts and some repealing Acts. In this regard Sections 6,6-C, 7 and 24 of Uttar Pradesh General Clauses Act, 1904, are to be referred, which are as follows:-

Section 6- Effect of repeal- Where any Uttar Pradesh Act repeals any enactment hitherto made or hereafter to be made, then unless a different intention appears, the repeal shall not-

- (a) revive anything not in force or existing at the time at which the repeal takes effect; or
- (b) affect the previous operation of any enactment so repealed or anything duly done or suffered thereunder; or
- (c) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under any enactment so repealed; or
- (d) affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any enactment so repealed; or
- (e) affect any remedy, or any investigation or legal proceeding commenced before the repealing Act shall have come into operation in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid;

and any such remedy may be enforced and any such investigation or legal, proceedings may be continued and concluded, and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment imposed as if the repealing Act had not been passed.

Section 6-C Repeal of expiration of law making textual amendments in other laws-

- (1) Except as provided by sub-section (2) where any Uttar Pradesh Act amends the text of any Uttar Pradesh Act or Regulation by the express omission, insertion or substitution of any matter, and the amending enactment is subsequently repealed, the repeal shall not affect the continuance of any such amendment made by the enactment so repealed and in operation at the time of such repeal.
- (2) Where any such amendment of text is made by any temporary Uttar Pradesh Act or by an Ordinance or by any law made in exercise of the power of the State Legislature by the President or other authority referred to in sub-clause (a) of clause (1) of Article 357 of the Constitution, and such Act, Ordinance or other law cease to operate without being re-enacted (with or without modifications) the amendment of text made thereby shall also cease to operate.

Section-7 Revival of repealed enactments-

In any Uttar Pradesh Act, it shall be necessary, for the purpose of reviving, either wholly or partially, any enactment wholly or partially repealed, expressly to State that purpose.

Section 24-Continuaton of appointments, notifications, orders etc. issued under enactments, repealed and re-enacted-

Where any enactment is repealed and re-enacted by an Uttar Pradesh Act, with or without modification, then, unless it is otherwise expressly provided, any appointment, or statutory instrument or form made or issued under the repealed enactment shall, so far as it is not inconsistent with the provisions re-enacted, continue in force, and be deemed to have been made or issued under the provisions so re-enacted unless and until it is superseded by any appointment, or statutory instrument or form made or issued under the provisions so re-enacted.

3.3 In view of above provisions repeal of following enactments included in the First Schedule will not adversely affect the present Acts particularly the Principal Acts and it will ease the burden of statute book.

3.4 Therefore, we recommend the following enactments specified in the First Schedule for their repeal to the extent mentioned in the Fifth Column thereof.

3.3 Second Schedule-

3.3.1 Second Schedule includes 23 such enactments which cover the areas of Uttarakhand State which came into existence after re-organization of Uttar Pradesh State. Now these Acts have no jurisdiction over Uttarakhand region as such. If these Acts are repealed, it has no adverse effect and it will be just to remove the dead wood on the statute book.

3.4 Third Schedule-
